Meet with your counselor to talk about a healthcare career.

Select a healthcare magnet school or other early college school with a healthcare track.



During high school, focus on sciences first! Prerequisites like anatomy, physiology, chemistry and microbiology can put you steps ahead of other nursing school applicants, especially if your school offers dual credits!

Take advantage of healthcare certifications, like CPR, and other hands-on experience opportunities your school or community offers.



Check-in with your advisor during your Junior Year to review your transcripts and make sure you're still on track.
