Meet with a school advisor to discuss your plan and options. Apply to nursing school.


Starting higher education for the first time or returning to finish your first degree? Follow this path towards your career in nursing.

Get a copy of your transcripts and meet with a school advisor.

Determine what prerequisites are necessary and begin taking classes before entering a nursing program.

With the help of your advisor, select a nursing program that is right for you. Some of the tracks that may be available to you are a BSN (3-4 years) or an accelerated BSN (16 months)

Take your entrance exams.



Get a copy of your transcripts and meet with a school advisor.

Based on an evaluation of your transcripts, determine what prerequisites you are missing and decide on what type of program to enter.

Select programs that are right for you. Some of the tracks that may be available to you include a second degree (1-2 years), a BSN (3-4 years), an entry MSN (2-3 years), or an accelerated BSN (16 months).

Take your entrance exams.
